

A Note from Carol....

This month I want to write about National Nurses Week. It begins May 6th and ends on May 12th, which happens to be the birthday of Florence Nightingale. She might be the most famous nurse that we know of, but I want you to know that we have some pretty awesome nurses here at the Rockwell Nursing Home. They might not be famous but are certainly the most dedicated, caring and committed nurses around!

Florence Nightingale (May 12, 1820 – August 13, 1910) was a celebrated English social reformer, statistician and founder of modern nursing. She became well known while taking care of the wounded soldiers during the Crimean War. Nightingale was dubbed "The Lady with the Lamp" because of her habit of making rounds at night. Annually we celebrate the profession of nursing to raise awareness of all the contributions, commitments and to acknowledge the important role that nurses play in the medical field.

The following is the Florence Nightingale pledge that we as nurses, state during the pinning ceremony at Nursing School.

"I solemnly pledge myself before God and in presence of this assembly, to pass my life in purity and to practice my profession faithfully. I will abstain from whatever is deleterious and mischievous, will not take or knowingly administer any harmful drug. I will do all in my power to maintain and elevate the standard of my profession, and will hold in confidence all personal matters committed to my keeping and all family affairs coming to my knowledge in the practice of my calling. With loyalty will I endeavor to aid the physician in his work, and devote myself to the welfare of those committed to my care."
