The day the music died... February 3rd, 1959, Clear Lake, IA

Buddy Holly Trivia....Did you know???

Died when his chartered plane (N 3794 N) crashed. Also on board and killed in the crash were Ritchie Valens and The Big Bopper (J.P. Richardson).

His date of death (February 3, 1959) was forever immortalized as "The Day the Music Died" in the song "American Pie" by Don McLean.

Waylon Jennings was part of Buddy's backup group and was supposed to be on the fateful flight but instead allowed an ill Big Bopper to take his place.

Buddy's group was The Crickets. They stayed together after his death.

1955 graduate of Lubbock High School

High school girlfriend was named Echo.

Surname was originally spelled "Holley" but misspelled "Holly" on his first recording contract & the error was never corrected.

Charter member of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1986.

He was voted the 13th Greatest Rock 'n' Roll Artist of all time by Rolling Stone.

Was portrayed by Gary Busey in The Buddy Holly Story (1978)

New Medicare cards will be issued by CMS and recipients can expect to receive them between April 2018 and April 2019. Your social security number will be removed from your card and your new Medicare number will be unique to you. Coverage or benefits wil remain the same.

CMS recommends that your mailing address is up to date. If it needs to be corrected, contact Social Security at ssa.gov/myaccount or call 1-800-772-1213.

Beware of anyone who contacts you about your new Medicare card. CMS would never ask you to give them personal or private information to get your new Medicare number or card.

Also, understand that mailing everyone a new card will take some time. Your card might arrive at a different time than your friend's or neighbor's.
