"Handwashing is the single most important means of preventing the spread of infection." CDC

80% of all infectious diseases are transmitted by touch. Handwashing remains the most effective way of removing germs from our hands that cause illnesses, such as the common cold or more serious infections that are resistant and difficult to treat with antibiotics. The simple task of washing your hands or using a hand sanitizer rub can help avoid illness to your own self, a so-called "do-it-yourself vaccine" (according to the CDC); as well as, preventing the spread of germs to others. Good hand hygiene is especially important in areas where people congregate: in your home where food is prepared and shared, in the community – in churches, restaurants and stores, where young adults and children spend most of the day – in daycares, schools and colleges, and where ill or vulnerable people are concentrated – in hospitals and nursing homes. The month of August is being dedicated to hand hygiene at the Rockwell Community Nursing Home. We will be updating and reviewing our hand hygiene practices for staff and residents. We, also, are encouraging family and friends to practice good hand hygiene, especially before and after visiting their loved ones. Hand sanitizer is placed at the entrances and in the hallways for you to use or staff can help you find a place to wash your hands if that is preferred.

REMEMBER TO WASH YOUR HANDS!

WHEN:

- ✓ Before making food
- ✓ Before eating food
- ✓ Before and after helping someone who is sick
- ✓ Before and after cleaning a cut or wound
- ✓ After using the toilet
- ✓ After putting on a diaper or cleaning a child who has used the bathroom.
- ✓ After blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing
- ✓ After touching an animal or cleaning animal waste
- ✓ After touching garbage

HOW:

Wet hands with clean, running water and put soap on your hands.

Rub hands together to make soap bubbles. Clean the backs of hands, between fingers and under nails.

Keep rubbing hand for 20 seconds.

Hum the "Happy Birthday" song twice. Wash off all soap under running water.

Dry hands with a clean towel.
