## STILL WAITING FOR YOUR NEW MEDICARE CARD?

It could be on the way. Here's how to check: Sign in to your MyMedicare.gov account and see if your card has been mailed. If you don't have an account yet, visit MyMedicare.gov to create one. Once your new card has mailed, you can sign in to see your new Medicare number or print an official copy of your new card.

Visit Medicare.gov/NewCard and check the map for the status of card mailings in your state. If the map shows that mailing is completed in your state, and you don't have your card, call 1-800-MEDICARE. 1-800-633-4227

There might be a problem that needs to be corrected, like updating your mailing address. In the meantime, use your current Medicare card to get health care services.

From the Social Worker's Desk ~

Occasionally incidents of alleged mistreatment of individuals in long-term care facilities make news headlines. The possibility of anyone becoming the victim of physical, emotional, verbal or financial abuse is unacceptable.

To aid in the protection of vulnerable individuals, the Iowa Code requires training for the mandatory reporting of dependent adult abuse. Long-term care employees are required to complete 2 hours of training within the first 6 months of employment and every 5 years thereafter. Any employee within their realm of employment is a mandatory reporter.

Additionally, other individuals may report suspected abuse as permissive reporters. Reporting of incidents involving a healthcare facility is to the Iowa Department Inspections and Appeals (1-877-686-0027) Abuse hotline (1-855-402-6116).

Our goal is to provide our residents with a safe, happy and homelike atmosphere. Everyone deserves the same.
