Open Enrollment-Medicare

Medicare Open Enrollment is coming up; October 15 thru December 7. Some plans change, some plans remain the same. If your plan has changed, make sure it's still the best plan to meet your healthcare needs. There may be another plan that works better for you!

You may find a Medicare Part C or Part D plan that lowers your out-of-pocket costs, provides better coverage for your current health care needs—or both. Compare and review plans before Open Enrollment ends on Dec. 7: http://go.cms.gov/planfinder


