#### Cyber Attack Training

On August 24th, the Nursing Home will participate in Cyber Attack Tabletop training hosted by CISA (Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency). The goal of the exercise is to help prepare of us for continuity of care and day-to-day operations in the event of a cyber-attack. In these times of high-tech hacking, cyber attacks are occurring more and more frequently.

A "tabletop" exercise is a meeting to discuss a simulated emergency situation. Members of various entities review and discuss the actions they would take in a particular emergency, (cyberattack in this scenario), testing their emergency plan in an informal, low-stress environment. Tabletop exercises are used to clarify roles and responsibilities and to identify additional mitigation and preparedness needs. The exercise should result in action plans for continued improvement of the emergency plan.

#### Hello from Nursing!

I hope that everyone has been able to get out and enjoy the summer. It has been great to see families coming in for visits more frequently. We continue to follow CMS, CDC, and IDPH guidelines and are updating and adjusting policies and protocols often.

We also continue to screen all visitors and staff before entering the building. Testing of staff is based on the county positivity rates. Per CMS the week of 7/18/2021 positivity rate was 12.8%, we are testing staff twice weekly until our positivity rate is below 5% for 2 weeks. With the recent spike and increase in the Delta variant cases in Iowa, we are on high alert. If the positivity rate continues to rise or we have an outbreak, we may have to stop outings and indoor visitation for a short period of time.

Now is the time that other viruses such as RSV in children and Influenza start to become more prevalent. If you or anyone in your family who is visiting are experiencing any cold or flu symptoms, runny nose, fever or have been exposed to COVID in the past 14 days, please refrain from visiting.
